

Navigation & Orienteering Training

- ◆ Do you feel uncomfortable about taking your Unit into new locations?
- ◆ Do you want to improve your navigation and route-finding skills?
- ◆ Have you considered orienteering as an activity for improving your Scouts' map and compass skills?

A workshop and field experience in navigation and orienteering will be conducted by members of the LAAC-HAT, in association with the Los Angeles Orienteering Club, on November 17-18 at the Firestone Scout Reservation. The program will be conducted in two parts. We will begin Saturday with a discussion of the tools of navigation and strategies for their utilization. Topics will include (but are not limited to) GPS, collecting terrain features, disoriented/lost, etc. We will also discuss Orienteering Events; how they are run and why they are useful in route-finding and off-trail navigation. These activities will be followed by participant-led map-hikes which use the detailed Orienteering Map for Firestone. After Saturday night's potluck dinner, we will organize a "Night-O", which will emphasize techniques for getting un-lost. Participants will help officiate in an LAOC Orienteering meet on Sunday.
